It was a very cheerful and meaningful 2-days. The 4 sessions (2 per day) were taught by our hub coordinator who has been a chess lover since she was 6. There were totally 26 players, from age of 4 to 79, with different background (none of them can read Chinese) came together in Hub to learn how to play the two long history traditional strategic games patiently and actively.

Everyone started learning Chinese Chess by recognizing and understanding the meaning of each traditional Chinese characters on the pieces. Through practicing repeatedly with other participants, 90% of the players could master the 2 new games well. Parents and friends got to relax in the comfort of this hub and mingled with their neighborhood.
